Will you support legislation to require the Governor and the Board of Trustees of the Employees' Retirement System to consider board nominees put forth by the Georgia State Retirees Association in the same manner as is presently done for vacant positions on the Teachers Retirement System Board of Trustees?
- 4. Will you support legislation to authorize COLAs for all state retirement systems?
- 5. Will you support protection of consumers by eliminating balance billing by health insurance providers?
